continuing education settings. She has provided continuing education seminars nationwide in the areas of administration, Medicare, billing and coding, compliance, and neurological rehabilitation. She has taught in the academic setting at MUSC and at Western Carolina University (WCU) and has taught the Administration class for the students at WCU since 2001.

Dr. Leonard has been recognized for her teaching ability as the past recipient of the Educator of the Year Award for the South Carolina Area Health Education Consortium, the J. Dale Pounds Award for a person who makes a significant impact on the physical therapy students of Western Carolina University, the MUSC College of Health Professions Teacher of the Year Award and the MUSC Health Science Foundation Excellence in Teaching Award for Developing Faculty.
